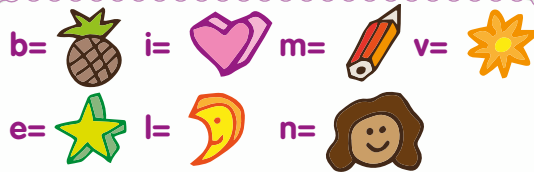
IN THE GOSPEL TODAY

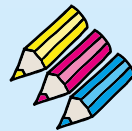

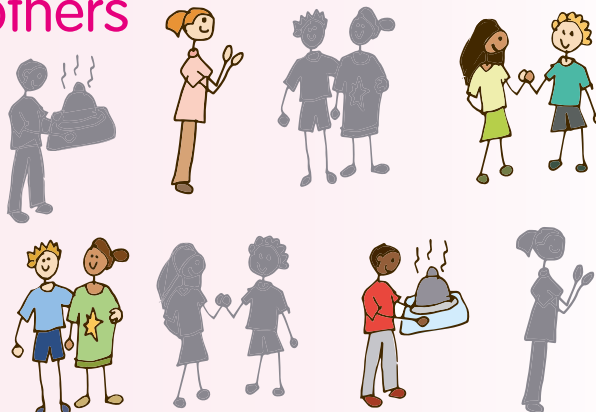

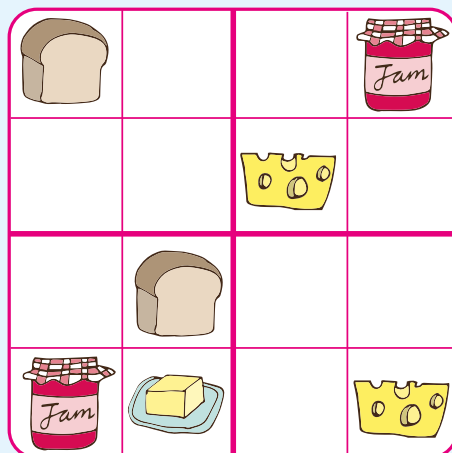

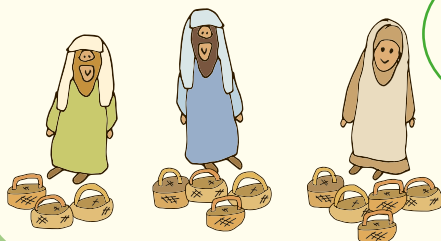
Sandwich sudoku
